PROACTIVE INTERCESSION FOR THE SALVATION AND DELIVERANCE OF NIGERIA FROM THE MIGHTY

2025: OUR YEAR OF FULFILLED DREAMS

GENESIS 41:1, GENESIS 42:9

- The word of God is established in heaven, unchallenged in authority and unshaken in permanence (**Psalm 119:89**). The issue is not whether God has spoken, but how His eternal word is brought to bear on earthly realities. Divine truth must move beyond information into revelation, personally received and inwardly understood.
- When revealed, the Word becomes a firm foundation for faith and obedience. Standing on it is not presumption, but alignment, for what God has spoken cannot fail. Heaven and earth may pass away, but His word will never go unfulfilled (**Matthew 24:35**).
- This message flows from a specific revelation the Lord gave me concerning Nigeria and those opposing its progress. The prophetic prayers and declarations that follow are therefore proactive responses to what has been divinely revealed, not mere expressions of desire.

**Texts: Isaiah 49:24-26, NKJV,
NLT, 1 John 5:14-15, NKJV**

- On Friday, October 31, 2025, Donald Trump, speaking within the White House environment, made a derogatory remark about Nigeria and declared, "We are coming, guns blazing, to undertake

a fast, vicious, and swift attack on terrorists."

- Thereafter, because the Lord had revealed these matters to me about a year earlier, I sent the following message to some of my sons and daughters in the faith on Tuesday, November 4, 2025.
 - The message read as follows: *"I perceive very strongly that the twenty-first-century global Sennacherib and his servants (the US president and his aides) will suffer what their predecessors suffered for threatening to attack Nigeria. If this is an empty statement, it will fall to the ground. However, it was written, spoken, and circulated because of what the Lord showed me in a vivid vision in November prior to this time."*

The Vision:

"Right at the entrance of Sabo Market, near the former bus stop, Air Force One landed. A global policeman, dressed in Saudi Arabian attire, emerged and said, 'At last, we are here.' I asked, 'You are here to do what?' He simply smiled. And I responded, 'Not here!'"

- If you have not seen, there is nothing you can say. That which our eyes have seen, our ears have heard, and our hands have handled constitutes the platform upon

which we stand to declare, “Thus saith the Lord” (*Isaiah 36:1-22; 37:1-7, 21-29, 36-38*).

- Some may ask: Why do you pray against Donald Trump? Did this global policeman not declare that his intention, at least publicly, was to fight for Christians in Northern Nigeria, to combat terrorists, and to confront those who have brutalised our brothers and sisters in the North? No right-thinking Nigerian would oppose positive international collaboration with our government to dismantle terrorist and bandit camps and eliminate their sponsors, whether in high or low places. Any right-thinking citizen should support such efforts in prayer, not pray against them.
- By God's grace, I deeply empathise with our brothers and sisters in the North, as well as with other peace-loving citizens—Christian and non-Christian alike—who have been traumatised by incessant attacks and the brutal murder of family members, neighbours, and friends.
- However, I see beyond the smoke screen of Donald Trump's so-called benevolence. In him, I discern the inordinate and ambitious spirit of Asahel—a man who ran errands for his king but ultimately became destructive. Asahel means “God sees” or “God has seen” (**2 Kings 8:7-13**).
- It does not matter what a man

declares; God looks at the intent of the heart (**1 Samuel 16:7**). The critical question, therefore, is this: what lies within Donald Trump?

- What Asahel became could have been averted, or at least his destructive tendencies minimised (**1 Kings 19:15-18**).
- Eventually, Asahel came to power and began to seize the territories of Israel, ripping open pregnant women, killing, and destroying, because there was no restraining factor in his life. Elijah did not fully obey God, and Asahel was left without proper restraint and anointing.
- You may ask, “What does all this have to do with Donald Trump?” If you are spiritually discerning, you will recognise that we are facing a clear and present danger. Just as Elijah failed to do what he was instructed, one must examine those surrounding Donald Trump, specifically those he appointed as his personal pastor, spiritual adviser, and head of the White House Faith Office during his presidency.
- Donald Trump appointed Paula White, a woman whose ministry is widely associated with monetised blessings and a controversial personal history. She is now known as Paula White-Cain, following her remarriage. During the first contest between Joe Biden and Donald Trump, she publicly declared: “We

command angels from Africa, warring angels, to come into America to push away all the enemies of Donald Trump.”

- This individual served as the spiritual head of the White House Faith Office. What kind of influence would such a person exert on Donald Trump? Would she act as a restraining force, or merely massage his ego? Would she confront reckless speech, or enable it? Would she speak truth to power, or simply reinforce his excesses? Paula White-Cain became Donald Trump's primary link to the evangelical community. That fact alone raises serious concerns.
- We are open to genuine foreign assistance. However, we remain firmly opposed to opportunistic foreign leaders with hidden agendas who seek to take advantage of us under the guise of help.

Prayer Point Five: Confusion in the Camp of the Wicked

- Let us ask the Lord, who sees all things and knows all hearts, to **throw confusion into the midst of the wicked**.
- Ask God to **ambush and frustrate all those who plot against the peace and stability of our nation**, whether terrorists, bandits, or their sponsors.
- Pray that every **covert and overt conspiracy against our land** be dismantled by divine

intervention.

Prayer Point Six: Exposure of False Patriots and Hidden Wickedness

- Since nothing is hidden that will not be revealed, let us ask the Lord to **expose every perverse person pretending to be a patriot**.
- Pray that all **wicked monsters in human flesh**—those supporting, shielding, or financing terrorism—be **uncovered and brought to judgement**.
- Ask the Lord to **expose daylight robbers** who hide under the guise of democracy to exploit our land and resources.
- Pray that, in His mercy, **God will cut them off and dismantle their influence**, in the name of Jesus.

Prayer Point Seven: Divine Retribution Against Evil Plots

- Ask the Lord to **return the evil plans of the wicked upon their own heads**.
- Pray that their schemes against Nigeria and Nigerians will **collapse suddenly and without remedy**.
- Ask for **divine implosion within their ranks**, resulting in confusion, exposure, and defeat.

Prayer Point Eight: Humiliation of Self-Appointed gods

- Ask the Lord to **humiliate those who have made themselves gods over this nation**, as He did to Pharaoh, Nebuchadnezzar, and Belshazzar.

- Pray that every **stronghold of arrogance, oppression, and brute force** be brought to an end.
- Ask God to **strip them of power, influence, and false authority**, in the name of Jesus.

DECLARATIONS

- **We declare** that every evil plan against our nation **is thwarted and frustrated**, in the mighty name of Jesus.
- **We declare** that every false patriot and hidden sponsor of terror is **exposed and brought into swift judgement**, in Jesus' name.
- **We declare** that the wicked fall by their own devices, and their destruction comes suddenly.
- **We declare** that those who exalt themselves as gods over this nation are **humbled by the hand of the Almighty**.
- **We declare** peace, stability, righteousness, and divine order over our land, **in Jesus' mighty name. Amen.**

President Theodore Roosevelt said:

- “Patriotism means to stand by the country. It does not mean to stand by the President, or any other public official, save exactly to the degree in which he himself stands by the country. It is patriotic to support him in so far as he efficiently serves the country. It is unpatriotic not to oppose him to the exact extent that, by inefficiency or otherwise, he fails in his duty to stand by the country. In

either event, it is unpatriotic not to tell the truth—whether about the President or about anyone else—save in the rare cases where this would make known to the enemy information of military value which would otherwise be unknown to him.”

I submit to you that a lost nation is one in which hungry and jobless people blindly support those who are responsible for their agony and misery.

Prayer Point Nine: Preservation of the Dream of a New Nigeria

- Let us pray and say: Lord, save Nigeria and heal Nigeria, in the mighty name of Jesus.
- Ask the Lord to **render useless all those attempting to scuttle, manipulate, or disrupt the process of actualising the dream of a new Nigeria**.
- Pray that everyone plotting to derail Nigeria's restoration, progress, and global relevance be **disarmed by divine power**.
- Ask the Lord to **frustrate their devices, neutralise their influence, and dismantle their strategies**, in the mighty name of Jesus.

Prayer Point Ten: Righteous Leadership Over the Nation

- According to **Proverbs 29:2**, when the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice. Let us ask the Lord to **raise and install righteous leaders over Nigeria at all levels of government —local,**

state, and federal.

- Pray that wicked leadership will be displaced and that **the groaning of the people will cease.**
- Ask that Nigeria be governed by leaders who **fear God, love justice, and serve the people**, in the mighty name of Jesus.

Prayer Point Eleven: Crowning the Year with Goodness

- Standing on **Psalm 65:11**, ask that the Lord's **abundance be our portion** as we walk in His paths.
- Declare that, regardless of present challenges or threats from the enemy, **God's goodness will prevail.**
- Ask the Lord to **crown our year with goodness and cause His abundance to overflow in our lives**, in Jesus' mighty name.

Prayer Point Twelve: Closing Prayer of Thanksgiving

- We began with thanksgiving, and we end with thanksgiving. Let us thank the Lord for **answering our prayers and granting our petitions.**
- Thank Him for **guiding, instructing, and enlightening us.**
- Thank Him that **no person with evil intentions will take advantage of our land or resources.**

- Ask the Lord to **protect all citizens—East, West, North, and South—from every form of invasion, destruction, or destabilisation.**
- Pray for deliverance from **destroyers who promise good but intend evil**, in the mighty name of Jesus.

DECLARATIONS

- **We declare** that Nigeria shall be saved, healed, and restored, in the mighty name of Jesus.
- **We declare** that every agenda to scuttle the dream of a new Nigeria is **rendered powerless.**
- **We declare** that righteous leaders shall arise, and the groaning of the people shall cease.
- **We declare** that the year 2025 is crowned with goodness, and God's abundance is our portion.
- **We declare** that our land is preserved from destruction, invasion, and long-term devastation.
- **We declare** that the Lord will deepen our understanding and **enlighten the eyes of our understanding, in Jesus' name.**
