



## GRACE SPEAKS

2026: OUR YEAR OF FRUITFUL LABOUR | 2 Chronicles 15: 7

- When grace comes upon your life, it initiates profound transformation. Certain changes inevitably begin to unfold, as the grace of God releases new capacities, possibilities, and outcomes that were previously beyond human effort (**2 Peter 1:1-3, NKJV, AMPC, TPT**).
- It is an undeniable truth that grace can be multiplied (**2 Peter 1:2-3, John 1:16**). The Bible reveals that grace increases through the knowledge of God and of Jesus Christ (**2 Peter 1:2-3, Philippians 1:9**). However, this multiplication does not occur automatically; it grows in proportion to one's increasing knowledge of, and intimacy with, Christ (**Colossians 1:10, Ephesians 3:16-19**).
- Being rooted and grounded in the word of God is non-negotiable (**Ephesians 3:17, Colossians 2:6-7**). If you are to grow in grace, if grace is to be multiplied in your life and your labour to become truly fruitful, your spiritual development must be deliberate and measurable in the areas where you are trusting God for growth (**2 Peter 3:18, John 15:5, Galatians 5:22-23**).
- Whatever it is you are trusting God for, grace must multiply. It is through that multiplication that growth becomes tangible, evident, and productive (**2 Peter 1:2-3, John 1:16**).
- If we were truly maximising the grace and full potential of grace in our lives, the Bible would not have warned us against receiving the grace of God in vain (**2 Corinthians 6:1**).
- What is grace saying? (**Titus 2:11-15, NKJV, AMPC, NLT, TPT**). Grace transforms our nature when we allow it to complete its work within us. This is the fundamental difference between grace and the law. Under the law, the relationship is that of master

and servant. Under grace, it is a relationship rooted in love (Romans 5:8).

- The greatest expression of love was revealed when Christ died for us while we were still sinners (Romans 5:8).

- Grace also speaks of salvation (Titus 2:11-15). Even if we were born into Christian homes, without God's calling and the indwelling of His Spirit, who knows what we would have become? Perhaps the greatest work of grace is to bring every person into salvation.
- How much have we done to extend salvation to those around us? Are we even aware of our responsibility, that the grace of God in our lives must not be in vain? (2 Corinthians 6:1). We are called to share the beauty and power of the salvation we have received with all people (Matthew 28:19-20, Titus 2:11-15).
- Those who are still experiencing the grace of God but have not yet been born again are being given time for a purpose. God is extending His mercy so that, by every means, they may come to salvation (Romans 2:4, 1 Timothy
