When Walking with God Seems Difficult

In John 21:1-7, a transaction took place at the Sea of Tiberias. In verse 3, the Bible says Peter told the other disciples who were with him that he was going fishing. When I asked myself why Peter would go fishing at that time, I concluded that it is very difficult to walk with God sometimes. The truth is, there are complications along the way when you begin to walk with the Lord. And the reason some of us have not faced any difficulty at all is because we have not been walking with the Lord.

The church today has confused God with "the society" called the church. God is not the church; the church is not God. You may say God sits in society, but that does not make society God. Many of us have confused the church with God, and so we play church Sunday in, Sunday out.

Based on the disciples' expedition at the Sea of Tiberias in John 21:1-7, I would like to submit to you that it is not easy walking with God. First, God is infinite while we are finite. He made it clear in Isaiah 55:8-9 that His thoughts and ways are far from our thoughts and ways. So, if the invisible and omnipotent God begins to walk with you, it can sometimes be complicated and confusing. What would make the disciples, after the resurrection of Jesus Christ, go to the Sea of Tiberias? What would make Peter say he was going fishing?

It all started when John the Baptist preached that the kingdom of heaven was at hand (Matthew 3:1-6). He also testified that Jesus was the Messiah (John 1:33-34). So, Andrew, Peter, James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, left their boat and

fishing career to follow Jesus because they saw in Him the attributes of the King of a kingdom (Mark 1:16-20;10:35, Matthew 4:18-22, Luke 5: 2-11). In their rational thinking, they thought Jesus would deliver them from the oppression of Rome and set up His kingdom. So, they began to serve and walk with Him. But while they were walking with Him, they did not fully understand Him.

However, as they were walking with Him and serving Him, Jesus began to show a tremendous demonstration of God's power. He walked on water, cast out demons, calmed the storm, and turned water to wine (Matthew 14:22-36; 8:28-34; 4:35-41, John 2:1-10). Therefore, the disciples were so excited to be in ministry with Jesus Christ that they began to boast about Jesus. They believed He was going to set up a kingdom that would deliver them from their problems (Luke 24:21). So, they left everything and followed Jesus (Luke 5:1-11).

But after three years of ministry, the same Jesus was apprehended (Matthew 26:36-56, John 18:4-6). His captors beat Him, slapped Him, spat on Him, tore His back with strokes of cane, put a crown of thorns on His head, tore His garment, drove nails into His hands and feet, and

lifted Him on the cross. Yet, Jesus did not say a word (Luke 22:63-23:12, John 18:22-23, Matthew 26:67, John 19:1-3, 23-24, Mark 15:24, Isaiah 53:7-10). The same Jesus who had demonstrated the tremendous power of God could not fight back when He was subjected to all kinds of ridicule and inhumane treatment. When the disciples saw all of that, they became confused. Peter denied Him and all the disciples scattered (Matthew 26:69-75, Mark 14:50, Zechariah 13:7, Mark 14:26-52). Nobody understood Him at this time.

To compound the matter, Jesus was buried. On the third day, He rose again and revealed Himself to the disciples (John 19:38-42, 1 Corinthians 15:4, Luke 24:1-8, John 20:19-20). Yet, they became more confused. So, Peter became fed up and the rest of them were dazed. Consequently, Peter went back to his fishing profession.

Is It Working?

The disciples' objective at the Sea of Tiberias was to catch fish. They laboured all night and caught nothing. But when Jesus came to them and asked whether they had any food, He was not just asking them whether they caught fish. He was asking them a simple question: "Is what you are doing working?" Remember, they would have tried every method they knew but to no avail.

How could they achieve what they could not achieve without the Lord's presence? Each time God asks a finite man a question, I believe He wants to confront such a person. In **Genesis 3:9** when God asked Adam where he was, do you think God did not know where Adam was? Of course, God knew. But God wanted Adam to see the mess he had brought himself into (**Genesis 3:9-13**). The same thing happened when the Lord said to Cain, "Where is Abel your brother?" (**Genesis 4:9-12**). God wanted Cain to know that his brother's blood was already crying from the ground.

When God asks you if there is anything impossible for Him to do (Genesis 18:14, Jeremiah 32:27), He wants to confront

you and challenge your religiosity for you to know that what you are involved in is not working (John 21:5). Deliverance begins when you admit you do not know how to do it.

It is About Relationship, Not Titles

When the disciples admitted that they could not do it, Jesus instructed them to throw their net to the right side of the boat. Then the Bible says they caught a multitude of fish (John 21:1-6). The first lesson I want you to see is that the Lord had been there all night long through their struggle. Therefore, the first thing you must do to get "meat" is to get in touch with Jesus again.

In verse 7 of John 21, the Bible says a particular disciple told Peter that it was the Lord. Although the Bible did not mention his name, we know it was John. The Bible simply describes him as that disciple whom Jesus loved. It emphasises his relationship with the Lord, not his title. God is not interested in the titles we wear; He is interested in our relationship with Him.

You Cannot Afford to Give Up

Before Jesus showed up that morning and asked them if they had any meat, the Bible says they had laboured all night but caught nothing. But when they obeyed the Lord's instruction, they caught a multitude of fish. You must not give up, regardless of circumstances and situation.

The reason you are desperate and about to give up is that the devil knows you are very close to your miracle, especially at the time when you are about to park your "boat." Each time you are about to give up, learn to go back to your prayer closet to pray again and worship God because you are very close to your miracle.

No matter how long it takes, for as long as you keep believing in the Lord and keep on walking in righteousness and holiness before Him, He will hold your miracle for you, though it may take a long night. The place of your struggle is the place of your breakthrough.

Between Raw Blessing and Prepared Blessing

From the disciples' encounter with Jesus, I discovered that the greatest challenge of life is knowing what to do after your breakthrough. The moment John told Peter that it was the Lord, the greatest challenge of life came. Should Peter stay with his fish in the boat, or should he jump out of the boat to meet Jesus? That was the challenge of life for Peter! The same thing applies to all of us. After the Lord has blessed you in the area you have been trusting Him for, should you keep your blessing and keep praising Him, or should you jump out of your "boat" to meet the Blesser?

Peter left the blessing (fish) behind and began to swim towards Jesus. He left his failure of the night and the success of the morning behind to swim towards Jesus. He counted all things as dung that he might win the excellency of Christ (John 21:7-8, Philippians 3:7-14).

Peter left his breakthrough behind because he preferred the Blesser to the blessing, the Healer to the healing, and the Deliverer to the deliverance. He swam towards Jesus. When he got to the shore where Jesus was, he saw that the Lord had already prepared breakfast for them. Peter thought he left his breakthrough behind, but he did not know that if one can give it up, one can have it all. Peter left a raw blessing in the boat; however, by the time he got to the shore, a prepared blessing was waiting for him (John 21:9).

If you can give it up, you can have it all.
