2025: OUR YEAR OF FULFILLED DREAMS GENESIS 41:1, GENESIS 42:9

- Every believer must know how to connect with God (**Luke 11:1-4**).
- From the outcome of the stories of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, and the fiery furnace, as well as that of Daniel in the lions' den, it is very clear that the faithfulness of God to those who believe and utterly depend on Him is absolutely unquestionable (**Daniel 3; 6:16-23**).
- You cannot see the glory of God and still have doubts in your heart. The reason you are not sure of the kind of dream you have is because it is not from God. When a dream is from God, you will wake with God's presence (**Genesis 12:1-8; 28:16**).
- Here are three definitions of a dream from the Noah Webster's Dictionary. **First:** "A dream is a series of thoughts which occupy the mind of a sleeping person in

which he imagines he has a view of real things and transactions" (**Genesis 40:5, 8; 41:15, Daniel 2:1-3**).

- **Second:** "A dream is a series of thoughts not under the command of reason and hence it is sometimes wild and irregular."
- **Third:** "In scriptures, dreams were sometimes impressions on the minds of sleeping persons made by divine agency" (**Genesis 20:1-7, Matthew 2:18-15**).
